Governor's Excellence in Energy Awards

Nomination Instructions

Do you have a Utah energy story to tell? Submit a nomination form for yourself, your company or another person or organization to be recognized as a Utah energy development leader. Tell us how your company or organization has gone above and beyond the expected in environmental leadership, community leadership or energy innovation.

Awards will be presented by Governor Gary R. Herbert at the Governor's Energy Development Summit on June 4, 2014.

Eligibility and Entry Deadlines

All submissions must include the Energy Awards Nomination Form, a two-page summary and up to six digital slides with photos or graphics describing your energy story.

Applications must be submitted before April 8, 2014.

Winners will be notified by May 1, 2014, and will be recognized at the Governor's Energy Development Summit on June 4, 2014.

Eligible applicants include anyone with an energy development, outreach or education project in Utah, including: local governments, agencies, educational institutions, tribes, companies, builders, consultants, non-profit organizations and individuals.

Criteria for Judging

Entries will be judged on one or more of the criteria below:

- Exceeding existing regulatory or permitting requirements.
- Mitigating environmental impacts including land, air, water and wildlife.
- Demonstrating community involvement, education and outreach.
- Utilization of new technology or innovative applications of existing technology.
- Demonstration of significant economic value to the industry, State, and public.

Award Categories

One award winner will be selected from each of the three categories below.

Energy Environmental Leader of the Year:

Recognizes applicants that distinguish themselves through energy practices that reduce impacts to the environment, including land, air, water, wildlife, etc. This leader will have shown a willingness to go above and beyond requirements by law.

Energy Community Leader of the Year:

Recognizes applicants that distinguish themselves through energy practices that benefit the local or regional community through job growth, citizen engagement, education, outreach or other service.

Energy Innovator of the Year:

Recognizes applicants that distinguish themselves through design or implementation of innovative energy programs, technologies, strategies, purchases or processes.
