



Solar PV Tax Credit **How to Resolve Audits**

I just received a notice that I am being audited. What do I do?

Share a copy of your TC-40E document with the Utah State Tax Commission or your accountant.

I have never applied for a TC-40E, where do I go?

Please visit energy.utah.gov/solar to learn about how create an account and submit an application to receive a TC-40E. At energy.utah.gov/solar you will be connected to oed2.fluidreview.com to register for an account and begin an application. Once you submit your application, you will receive an email notification from energytaxcredits@utah.gov about your submittal and the approximate timeframe for review. It is recommended that you follow up with the tax commission when you submit as the review timeframe may surpass your audit deadline.

I have already applied but have misplaced my TC-40E document, how can I get a copy?

Please email the following information to energytaxcredits@utah.gov with the subject line "Request for Assistance on Audit":

- The address where the solar PV system was installed
- The full taxpayer name(s)
- The year the solar PV system was installed
- The year the solar PV tax credit application was submitted

I am unsure if a TC-40E application has ever been submitted, how do I find out?

We recommend first contacting your solar installer to see if they have one on file. If they are unable to confirm that the TC-40E was issued, please follow the above procedures to email the Governor's Office of Energy Development regarding your inquiry and include a statement about your uncertainty of submitting.
