

Summary: The South African Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE) is seeking proposals (in English) to generate 2000MW through The Gas Independent Power Producer Procurement Programme (GASIPPP). Advocacy support is available to U.S. companies submitting an application.

Deadline: August 30, 2024

Types of Business Contacts Trade Lead is Seeking: Independent Power Producers (IPPs) and technology providers.

Product or Service Trade Lead is Seeking: A total of 2000 megawatts (MW) will be procured in this first round from Projects supplying new generation Capacity, Ancillary Services and Energy Output to be produced from gas-fired power generation technology. This Gas IPP Procurement Programme specifically targets land-based electricity generation facilities utilizing natural gas, located anywhere within the borders of the Republic of South Africa.

Organization Description: On 29 May 2019, President Cyril Ramaphosa announced the merger of the Department of Mineral Resources and the Department of Energy into one department, as the Department of Mineral resources and Energy (DMRE). The existence of the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy is premised on its vision of becoming a leader in the transformation of South Africa's economic growth agenda through the sustainable development of the mining and energy sectors.
